



About Mumbo Island - Info and Prices

Mumbo Island is a pristine and deserted tropical island and is the undisputed jewel of the Lake Malawi National Park. Mumbo Island has never been inhabited and is still in its natural state with a thick covering of miombo woodland and ancient fig and baobab trees.

The waters around the island are clean and calm, perfect for all guests - irrespective of fitness or experience - to enjoy sea kayaking, snorkeling and SCUBA diving. The island's only mammals – Spotted-necked Otters - are remarkably curious and playful, and regularly join guests for a snorkel or swim.

The tiny island camp, with capacity for only fourteen guests, features six

tastefully furnished reed chalets with shaded decks, hammocks, hot bucket showers and 'eco-loos'. There is a dining area with bar and lounge, and a watersport deck on the beach, leaving the rest of the island untouched.

The camp is built of timber, thatch, reeds and canvas, and is perched on high rocks overlooking the water, blending with the African bush to create a 'Robinson Crusoe' atmosphere of rustic charm.

The whole island is part of the Lake Malawi National Park and falls within Kayak Africa's exclusive concession area, guaranteeing privacy in paradise.

CAMP DETAILS IN BRIEF:

- Maximum number of guests is fourteen, although larger groups are possible when it is just one party booking the whole island.
- Camp accommodation consists of five double/twin reed chalets positioned on high rocks overlooking the water; plus one four-bed family chalet positioned in the forest on the main island. The family chalet is safe for small

children and is also closer to the dining room making it convenient for older guests as well.

- All chalets are fully-furnished with mosquito netting and have en-suite bathrooms.
- The camp is off-grid and there is no electricity in the chalets.
- On Mumbo Island barefoot luxury is the theme. The camp is run according to strict eco-friendly principles, meaning that there is everything you need and nothing that you don't.
- No cash is required while on the islands – all chargeable items are put on a tab which is settled back at reception.
- Reception is on the mainland beach at Cape Maclear. Secure parking is available for self-drive guests.

FARE BASIS:

- Accommodation rates include three meals per day, all kayaking and snorkeling activities and equipment, and all National Park fees and taxes. Also included are purified water and bottomless cups of tea, coffee and cooldrink.
- Rates exclude bar drinks, SCUBA diving, sailing and wellness therapies.
- The "extra" rate applies to any third person in a unit; the half-day camp fee applies to guests that arrive on the morning boat but depart

on the afternoon boat.

- PADI-certified SCUBA courses and casual dives for qualified divers are available. Please contact us for details.
- Low season rates are valid from 22 February 2019 until 30 June 2019, and from 1 November 2019 to 13 January 2020; high season rates are valid from 1 July 2019 until 31 October 2019. (These seasons and dates do not apply to ALL season rates.)
- Terms and conditions apply. We reserve the right to change prices if necessary.

BOAT TRANSFERS:

- Mumbo Island is 10km from Kayak Africa reception at Cape Maclear.
- Boat transfers between reception and the island run according to the Boat Transfer Schedule.
- All boat transfers that are part of the Boat Transfer Schedule are included in the accommodation rates, ie there is no additional charge.
- The Boat Transfer Schedule is as follows:

Mornings:

- Depart Mumbo Island for Reception 09h30
- Depart Reception for Mumbo Island 10h30

Afternoons:

- Depart Mumbo Island for Reception 14h00
- Depart Reception for Mumbo Island 15h00

- Any off-schedule boat transfers will attract the surcharge as detailed in the price table above. Off-schedule options are as follows:

Mornings:

- Depart Mumbo Island for Reception 06h00

Afternoons:

- Depart Reception for Mumbo Island 17h00

- Boat transfer times will be determined at the time of booking and will be included in the invoice.
