Camp Details in Brief:

- Maximum number of guests is fourteen, although larger groups are possible when it is just one party booking the whole island.
- Camp accommodation consists of five double/twin Island Chalets perched on high rocks overlooking the water; plus one four-bed Forest Chalet secluded in the forest on the main island. The Forest Chalet does not have a lake view but is safe for small children and is also closer to the dining room making it convenient for older guests as well.
- All chalets are fully-furnished with mosquito netting and have en-suite bathrooms.
- The camp is off-grid and there is no electricity in the chalets. Each chalet has portable solar lamps and there is a centrally-located solar-powered charging station for cellphones.
- On Mumbo Island barefoot luxury is the theme. The camp is run according to strict eco-friendly principles, meaning that there is everything you need and nothing that you don't.
- No cash is required while on the islands – all chargeable items are put on a tab which is settled back at reception.
- Reception is on the mainland beach at Cape Maclear. Secure parking is available for self-drive guests.



Fare Basis:

- All accommodation rates are per person per night, and include all National Park fees and taxes.
- Rates are self-catered - all food provision and preparation is the responsibility of the guests. Island Staff will service the fully-equipped kitchen and dining room after each meal.
- Fully-catered meals or chef services are available and must be added at the time of booking.
- Rates exclude kayaking and snorkelling activities and equipment, SCUBA diving and bar drinks.
- The "extra" rate applies to any third person in a unit; the half-day camp fee applies to guests that arrive on the morning boat but depart on the afternoon boat.
- PADI-certified SCUBA courses and casual dives for qualified divers are available. Please contact us for details.

Boat Transfers:

- Mumbo Island is 10km from Kayak Africa reception at Cape Maclear. Boat transfers between reception and the island run according to the Boat Transfer Schedule:
 - Mornings:

 - Depart Reception for Mumbo Island 10h30
 - Afternoons:
 - Depart Mumbo Island for Reception 14h00
 - Depart Reception for Mumbo Island 15h00
